

# 国际教育学院“五一”劳动节假期安全提醒

各位同学：

“五一”劳动节假期（5月1日至5日）即将来临，为确保大家度过一个平安、文明的假期，结合学校相关要求，现向全体同学发出以下安全提醒：

## 一、出行安全

**交通安全：**假期出行高峰，人流车流密集，请自觉遵守交通法规。骑行电动车时务必佩戴头盔，严禁违规载人。乘坐客运车辆要选择正规营运客车，乘车全程系好安全带。出行前要提前了解路况和天气，合理规划时间与路线，尽量错峰出行。

**户外活动安全：**避免涉足未开发或危险区域，注意防范强对流天气；在各类场所活动时留意安全出口，遇紧急情况有序撤离。禁止在户外违规用火，否则将承担法律责任。

**注意气候变化：**近期天气气候多变，出行前请密切关注气象部门发布的降水、强对流天气等预报预警和风险提醒。做好安全防范，不私自深入未开发或自然条件恶劣的地区。遇到灾害性天气尽量不外出，学习掌握相应的应急避险知识，科学防范应对灾害性天气。

## 二、健康与防疫

**传染性疾病预防：**前往人员密集场所时佩戴口罩，勤洗手；注意饮食卫生，选择正规餐饮场所就餐。

## 三、财务安全

个人财产安全：妥善保管好钱物、证件等。如需签字务必慎重，不要将身份证、学生证等个人重要证件原件及复印件轻易交予他人，外出时不要携带过多现金和贵重物品，背包一定要放在显眼的视野范围内。

防范电信诈骗：警惕低价换汇、冒充熟人、虚假购物等骗局，不轻信陌生链接或转账要求，不随意扫码或下载来路不明的软件，注意保护个人信息，避免泄露。

文明上网：遵守网络道德，不传播不实信息，不参与网络暴力，维护清朗网络空间。

#### **四、防火与用电安全**

宿舍安全：离开宿舍记得断电、拔插头，禁止使用高功率违禁电器。出门关好门窗，锁好贵重财物。严禁留宿他人。保持宿舍整洁卫生，多通风。

#### **五、留校与返校管理**

遵守宿舍管理规定，按时归寝；如有离开德州出游计划，请提前到419学生管理办公室填写申请表，按要求完成请假手续。

## Safety Reminder for Labor Day Holiday

Dear students,

The Labor Day holiday (May 1st to 5th) is approaching. To ensure a safe and civilized holiday, the International Education School hereby issues the following safety reminders in accordance with university regulations:

### **I. Travel Safety**

#### **1. Traffic Safety:**

During peak travel periods, traffic congestion is expected. Please obey traffic laws. When riding e-bikes, always wear a helmet and avoid carrying passengers illegally. Choose licensed passenger vehicles and fasten seat belts throughout the journey. Check the weather and road conditions in advance, plan your itinerary wisely, and travel during off-peak hours if possible.

#### **2. Outdoor Safety:**

Avoid undeveloped or hazardous areas. Be cautious of extreme weather (e.g., heavy rain, storms). Note emergency exits in public venues and evacuate calmly if needed. Open flames outdoors are strictly prohibited; violators will face legal consequences.

#### **3. Weather Awareness:**

Monitor weather forecasts (e.g., rainfall, thunderstorms) and heed official warnings. Avoid traveling to remote or high-risk locations. Stay indoors during severe weather and learn emergency response measures.

### **II. Health & Epidemic Prevention**

Wear masks in crowded areas and maintain hand hygiene. Dine at reputable establishments to ensure food safety.

### **III. Financial Security**

#### **1. Personal Belongings:**

Keep valuables (cash, IDs, etc.) secure. Avoid carrying excessive cash or expensive items. Never leave bags unattended in public.

#### **2. Fraud Prevention:**

Beware of scams (e.g., fake currency exchange, impersonation, phishing links). Do not click suspicious links, scan suspicious codes, download unverified apps, or disclose personal information.

#### **3. Online Conduct:**

Refrain from spreading misinformation or engaging in cyberbullying. Maintain a positive online environment.

### **IV. Fire & Electrical Safety**

-Dormitory Safety: Unplug devices before leaving; high-power appliances are prohibited. Lock doors/Windows and secure valuables. No overnight guests allowed. Keep rooms clean and well-ventilated.

### **V. On-Campus & Return Requirements**

Follow dormitory rules and return on time. If you have plans to travel outside Dezhou, submit a leave application at the Student Management Office (Room 419) in advance.

Return Deadline: Return to campus by **May 5th**. Resume classes on **May 6th**. Absences without exceptional reasons will not be approved.
